FIREARM AMNESTY

01 AUGUST 2020 - 31 JANUARY 2021

DID YOU KNOW?

When a **firearm license owner has passed away**, family members should not handle the firearm at all, but must **notify the nearest police station** immediately.

Do not take the firearm to the police station, instead notify the police about the firearm.

A firearm belongs to the owner of the license and not to the family. Anyone in possession of a firearm, after the owner has passed away, is in possession of that firearm illegally, can be charged with possession of firearm without license. Please notify the police after the owner of the license passed way.

A firearm must be kept in a safe or on your body. The safe keys where the firearm is kept, must be in your possession at all times.

Do not keep your firearm under the pillow, in a wardrobe, in a motor vehicle boot or cubbyhole (glove compartment).

When carrying a firearm on your body, it must **not be visible** and you must use the locked, reliable and **prescribed holster**.

REPORT ALL ILLEGAL FIREARMS YOU ARE AWARE OF IN AND AROUND YOUR AREA TO THE POLICE
